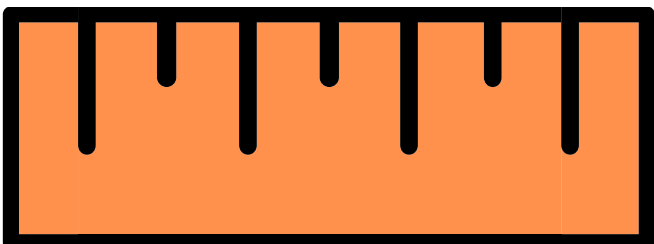
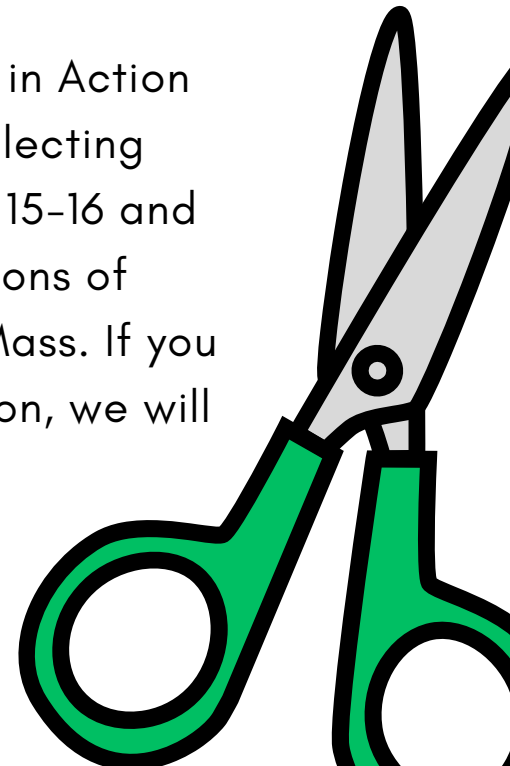
# PLEASE HELP!

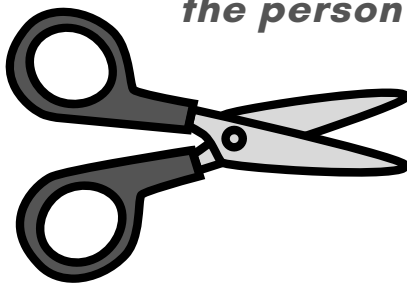
