Our teachers have done an amazing job dealing with COVID. The teachers are under a lot of stress. The federal government has authorized free hot lunch until the end of the year. The kids are going to the art and music rooms for class. Father said that Sister Angela and Kevin Naumann are doing a great job. There is a COVID tracker on the School website. There have been no cases of spreading the virus at the school.

New Business

The Holy Day of All Saints Day (November 1) falls on Sunday this year. It is not a day of obligation this year.

The Diocese is waiting for a decision from the Apostolic Nuncio on Bishop Connelly considering all the information available.

Advent might not have a penance service, but might have a group of priests come to hear confession.

Cana is getting ready to roll at Lincoln Station and virtually. Barry and Jeanne Johnson are organizing the event.

Saint Joseph's has been having one to two baptism's a week. We had 11 funerals in 30 days. None of those were due to COVID. Sunday masses are pretty much full in the Church. Additional capacity in Resurrection hall is still available. There is some excess capacity in the Church at the 5 PM Mass on Sunday.

A parishioner brought up a concern about the Parishes "Employee Compensation Philosophy and Practices". This generated considerable discussion. Ron Clinch will pursue clarification of the request.
