June Stewardship Meeting:

- CSA amount is over 333,000. We attributed success to personal invitations and repeated asks. Also the thermometer in the vestibule inspired some to give more to get us up to the goal. This is huge for our parish budget. Thank you so much to everyone that talked and worked the table and especially to Monica for taking the lead.
- Campaign for Leadership and Ministry Fair is scheduled for the weekend of August 21st-22nd. Courtney Verhoeff and Mikayla Pond will take the lead on this.
- We talked again about all ministries joining the 3x per year gathering that is currently for acolytes, ushers and lectors. General vision would be that this would be attended by at least one representative from each ministry. All leaders would receive general updates from Father and Father, then ministry leaders would split off from acolytes, ushers and lectors. We would then cast some vision for ministry leaders and facilitate some discussion. Ben Raun is taking the lead.
- Ben and Monica are going to make calls to our three potential new members who were interested in parish council. We could still use maybe two more additional members.

Action Items Completed:

- New kneelers have been installed.
- Confirmed pricing/approval for replacement of roof areas J, K, L, M, N. Work is scheduled to begin in August.
- Confirmed funding from the EANS grant (Emergency Assistance for Non Public Schools) will no longer be used for air purification and will now be used for technology upgrades.

- The van that was parked in the southwest corner of the parking lot has been moved.
- Repaired a leak/coil in the air handling unit which serves the Church.

Action Items In-progress/Pending:

Old Business

None addressed.

New Business

Budget approval

Finance meeting on June 16th. Ann presented the budget and the finance council approved it.

Discussion around the parish budget included:

- A lower budgeted income for Sunday and holy day collections
- A higher budgeted income for Cana and CSA
- The largest expenses for the parish are the transfer to St. Joseph School and Pius X High School (80% of income is spent on education of children)
- The expense for parish compensation and benefits increased due to the upcoming hire for Youth Ministry
- Our Diocesan Assessment (expense) decreased and is based on a number of factors including the annual tithe

Discussion around the school budget included:

- decrease in the expense for school compensation (teachers leaving, new teachers arriving)
- Decrease in the expense for instructional materials
- Increase in expense for Diocesan Technology Fee (this is covered by the Parish; other school are requiring the parents to cover the cost)
- School income increased in tuition (higher enrollment numbers for 2021-2022 school year)
- School income also increased in the school endowment distribution
