

**Minutes of meeting  
St. Joseph's Finance Council  
August 28th, 2018 @ 4:00 PM**

Fr. McCabe opened the meeting with a prayer.

Minutes from the last meeting of June 26th, 2018 were approved as distributed.

Scott Gubbels presented the dashboard information that he and Ann formulated. He thanked the individual at Union Bank who help format the template of information. Scott reviewed what he had and suggested the council review and get back to him with any changes or questions they may have so that he may tweak it and get it to be the most helpful to us.

The year-end P&L's for Church and School and the balance sheet had been sent out earlier. Ann mentioned that the \$70,000 bottom line profit on the school P&L is the one time tuition support that was received from a specific donor to cover planned tuition increase for the 2018-19 school year.

The OSV program was discussed along with a general discussion about other stewardship of treasure support opportunities for the parish. Fr. McCabe wants to do the OSV program again this coming Fall so the project is in motion.

Angie Muhleisen suggested that a better communication of our goals for overall fundraising for the parish be outlined and be made simple for everyone to understand. Fr. McCabe was receptive of this idea and suggested that any one on the finance council let him know their specific ideas on this. Ann suggested that maybe this should be a task of the parish council.

Father McCabe, Craig & Michael discussed the four pillar approach that is used by the Wichita Diocese. Michael was going to email the website for those of us who were not familiar with the four pillars. Craig leads the Stewardship committee for the parish. The Stewardship committee is planning a tithing Stewardship commitment event to be held sometime in 2019. Trying to make it be a more inclusive commitment opportunity for all giving opportunities in the parish. More detail on this to come.

Fr. McCabe also asked the members of the finance council to let him know what we think we do well as a parish and what we may not do so well as a parish. This information could be emailed to Ann and she could then get it to Father.
